The plan below, coupled with personal responsibility, presents our best efforts to keep our dancers, families, and staff safe. (Updated As of 9/4/2021)



Flu-Like Symptoms

Any student, staff, or parent that has flu-like symptoms, any symptoms of COVID-19 within the past 10 days, or have had any close contact with someone who is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days we ask that you please not attend class or enter the studio. A member of Linda's Ballet Workshop's Staff will check your child's temperature prior to entering the studio classroom. Anyone with an elevated temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will be sent home.



Face Coverings

As of 9/4/21 Masks are REQUESTED for all students, visitors and faculty regardless of vaccination status, at least through November 1st based on current best practices for protection of our LBW dance community and their families. We will update this policy every 60 days based on current CDC guidelines.

Reception Area

For the time being, the Reception Area will remain closed.

Parents and family will be asked to wait outside or in their car.

****We will be allowing dancers six years and younger who require assistance to be accompanied by one adult into the building.**** Please maintain social distancing while in the reception area.

Dancer Drop Off & Pick Up

Please be courteous and arrive at your class on time -no more than 10 minutes prior to class time. Students should be dropped off and picked up at the front door. After class, a staff member will have dancers collect their belongings. Parents must be in the reception room or outside by the studio door to receive their child. Students cannot be let out into the parking lot on their own after class for safety reasons. Parking is not allowed in the fire lane in front of the studio. Please be prompt for drop off and pick up.



Studio Cleanliness & Sanitization

Following the CDC Guidance for Cleaning and Disinfecting, each studio will be cleaned and dance equipment will be disinfected between each use. Staff will frequently clean and disinfect all commonly touched surfaces (e.g., barres, door handles) common areas (e.g., restroom room, reception room), and equipment. All cleaning materials are EPA-approved disinfectants against COVID-19 per CDC guidelines.



Hand Cleaning and Washing

Hand sanitizers are placed throughout the reception area and inside each studio, you will be required to cleanse your hands upon arrival. All faculty, staff and dancers should wash their hands regularly. The CDC recommends this as one of the best practices to avoid transmission of the virus.

Restrooms

To minimize usage, encourage dancers to use the restroom at home prior to class. The restroom will be sanitized regularly.

Drinking Fountain

The drinking fountain may be used *only* to refill water bottles.
